Rules and Regulation

Entry fees

1. Entry fee per participant is RM30.00 regardless to the number of events and type of event to be participated.

Biathlon (Swim + Run)

- 1. Participants to use the diving pool (5m depth) to complete their swim.
- 2. Participants are allowed to swim any swimming stroke.
- 3. The marshal will inform the participants if they have done the required swim distance in their category.
- 4. Participants MUST wear a pair of shoes before running.
- 5. Participants MUST wear the shirt completely that would be prepared by organizer before the run.
- 6. Parents are not allowed to guide or help the participant during the race.
- 7. There will be a marshal at regular corners throughout the route.
- 8. There will be an indicator given to the participants to indicate that they have finished the race.
- 9. Failure to follow instructions will lead to a disqualification.
- 10. The decision by organizers, marshals and the authorities are final.
- 11. The swimmer with the fastest time shall be declared the winner for the event followed by the rest in descending order.
- 12. The following are the minimum requirements to complete the Biathlon race.

<u>Category</u>	<u>Swim (laps)</u>	<u>Run (Rounds)</u>
8 years old & below	100 meters (4)	500 meters (1)
9 – 10 years old	150 meters (6)	1000 meters (2)
11 – 12 years old	250 meters (10)	1500 meters (3)
13 – 15 years old	500 meters (20)	2000 meters (4)
30 years old & above	500 meters (20)	2000 meters (4)

Swimming

- 1. The swimming event will be conducted according to the FINA rules.
- 2. The decisions of the organizing committee will be final.
- 3. All events are conducted as time finals.
- 4. The one start rule applies.
- 5. The swimmer with the fastest time shall be declared the winner for the event followed by the rest in descending order.
- 6. National and State swimmers are not eligible to participate.
- 7. No appeals allowed as referee decision is final.

Water Ball Relay

- 1. Each team should consist of 1 adult and 2 children.
- 2. Adult must be 30 years old and above.
- 3. Children must be 14 years old or below.
- 4. The adult must be a parent to one of the children in the same team.
- 5. A water ball will be provided to each team.
- 6. Participants are to hold the water ball with two (2) hands and kick for motion.
- 7. The water ball has to completely touch the wall before the next participant continues the race.
- 8. The team with the fastest time shall be declared the winner for the event with the rest in descending order.
- 9. National and state level swimmers are eligible to join.
- 10. Unfit or pullout of any team member will be considered as a withdrawal of the whole team.
- 11. The sequence of team members in the relay is open to the decision of the team.
- 12. Failure to follow instructions will lead to a disqualification.
- 13. The decision by organizers, marshals and the authorities are final.

Water Tube Raft Race

- 1. Each team should consist of 1 adult and 2 children.
- 2. Adult must be 30 years old and above.
- 3. Children must be 14 years old or below.
- 4. The adult must be a direct parent to one of the children in the same team.
- 5. A water tube will be provided to each team.
- 6. The adult requires to ride on the water tube raft and finishes 25m with 2 children pushing the raft.
- 7. The team with the fastest time shall be declared the winner for the event with the rest in descending order.
- 8. National and state level swimmers are eligible to join.
- 9. Unfit or pullout of any team member will be considered as a withdrawal of the whole team.
- 10. Failure to follow instructions will lead to a disqualification.
- 11. The decision by organizers, marshals and the authorities are final.
