

ASUM/NSC/MILO JUNIOR SPLASH SWIM 2019 – LEG 2

Competition Rules & Regulations

1. Name of Meet

The junior swimming meet shall be named ASUM/NSC/MILO Junior Splash Swim 2019 – LEG 2

2. <u>Aim</u>

The aim of the Junior Splash Swim, as the name suggests, is to provide an additional and suitable platform to encourage junior swimmers to be involved in competitions to identify potential swimmers at junior level aged fourteen (14) years and under.

3. Venue

Pusat Akuatik Hang Jebat, Krubong, Melaka

4. Date/Time

 Day 1 - Saturday,
 2nd NOVEMBER 2019 @ 8.00 a.m.

 Day 2 - Sunday,
 3rd NOVEMBER 2019 @ 8.00 a.m.

 Day 3 - Monday,
 4th NOVEMBER 2019 @ 8.00 a.m.

The pool will be opened for warm-up at 6.30 a.m.

5. Eligibility

Members from affiliates of Amateur Swimming Union of Malaysia and clubs affiliated to Malacca Amateur Swimming Association. No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.

6. Entry Restriction

Individual Events: No restriction on entries from each club/affiliate.

Team Events: One (1) team per club/affiliate. If the club/affiliate wishes to enter two (2) relay

teams, only the first team with a faster timing will be recognized for award. The relay entry forms with swimmers' names must be submitted to the Control Room

before lunch break on the day of competition.

7. Age Groups

a) Group 2: 13 to 14 years (Born between 02/01/2004 and 01/01/2006) b) Group 3: 11 to 12 years (Born between 02/01/2006 and 01/01/2008) c) Group 4: 9 to 10 years (Born between 02/01/2008 and 01/01/2010)

d) Group 5: 8 years and under (Born on 02/01/2010 and after)

Swimmers are only eligible to swim in their respective age grouping. No swimmers are allowed to swim up in the Relay Events.

8. Date of Reckoning

1st January 2019

9. Competition Format

All events will be held on Time Final basis.

10. Awards

Swimmers who obtained top three (3) positions for each event shall be awarded Medals and Certificates of Achievements. All participants will be awarded Certificates of Participations.

Event with less than two (2) swimmers may be swum by combining with another age group but ranked separately. However, minus one rule applies. In the case of only one participating swimmer in an event, medal and points will not be awarded, unless the swimmer breaks the meet record previously established.

Swimmers will be awarded points under each affiliate to determine the Champion Club as follows:

11. Entry Fees

- a) A registration fee of **RM100.00** per affiliate/club/team is payable;
- b) Individual entry fee of RM8.00 per event; and
- c) Team entry fee of RM32.00 per delay event.

Total entry fee is payable to MASA as per final checklist. Upon checklist confirmation by participating affiliates, there will be no revision to the entry fees in the event of subsequent withdrawals/scratching. No invoice will be issued

Please submit your duly completed entry forms together with the entry fees to MASA Secretariat before or latest by 3.00 p.m. Tuesday, 1st OCTOBER 2019. Late entries will not be entertained.

14. Team Managers' Meeting

There will be a meeting for all Team Managers at the Meeting Room, Deck Level, Pusat Akuatik Hang Jebat on Friday, 1st NOVEMBER 2019 at 4.00 p.m.

15. Events Scratching

Scratching or withdrawal of events is only allowed during Team Managers' Meeting. A penalty of RM25 will be imposed for each event scratched on the day of the meet (after the Team Managers' Meeting) unless a medical certificate is furnished. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day on presentation of a medical certificate.

16. Jury of Appeal

Jury of Appeal shall comprise of three (3) members from the Organizing Committee and two (2) Team Managers from participating clubs not involved in the Appeal.
