Competition Rules

1. Name of Meet : The junior swimming meet shall be named the MAS/NSC/MILO

Junior Splash Swim 2022 - LEG 1.

2. Aim : The aim of the Junior Splash Swim as the name suggests, is to provide

an additional and suitable platform to encourage junior swimmers to be involved in competitions and to identify potential swimmers at junior

levels age 14 years and under.

3. Venue : National Aquatic Centre

Kuala Lumpur Sports City, Bukit Jalil, Kuala Lumpur

4. Date/Time : Day 1 – Saturday, 14th May, 2022 @ 8:30 am.

: Day 2 - Sunday, 15th May, 2022 @ 8:30 am.

Day 3 - Monday, 16th May, 2022 @ 8:30 am.

The pool will be opened for warm-up at 7:00 am.

5. Eligibility : a) Members from affiliates of Malaysia Swimming Federation and schools

affiliated to Kuala Lumpur Amateur Swimming Association.

b) Para swimmers as sanctioned by Malaysia Swimming Federation.

c) No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.

6. Entry Restriction: Individual Events: No restriction on entries from each club/affiliate.

Team Events : One (1) team per affiliate

7. **Age Groups** : a) Group 2 : 13 to 14 years (Born on 2/1/2007 to 1/1/2009)

b) Group 3 : 11 to 12 years (Born on 2/1/2009 to 1/1/2011) c) Group 4 : 9 to 10 years (Born on 2/1/2011 to 1/1/2013) d) Group 5 : 6 to 8 years (Born on 2/1/2013 to 1/1/2016)

Swimmers are only eligible to swim in their respective age grouping. No

swimmers are allowed to swim up in the Relay Events.

8. Date of Reckoning: 1st January, 2022

9. Competition Format: All events will be held on Time Final basis.

10. Awards : Swimmers who obtained top 3 positions for each event shall be awarded medals

and Certificate of Achievements. All participants will be awarded Certificate of

Participations.

Events with less than 2 swimmers may swim combined with another age group but ranked separately. However, minus one rule applies. In the case of only one participating swimmer in an event, medal and points will not be awarded, unless the swimmer breaks the meet record, previously established.

Swimmers will be awarded points under each affiliate to determine the Champion Club as follows:

11. Entry Fees

- a) A registration & facility fee of RM50.00 per swimmer is payable;
- b) Individual entry fee of RM10.00 per event; and
- c) Team entry fee of RM40.00 per relay event.

Total entries fee is payable to PRAKL as per final entry checklist. Upon checklist confirmation by participating affiliates, there will be no revision to the entry fees in the event of subsequent withdrawals/scratching. No invoice will be issued.

15. Events Scratching: Scratching or withdrawal of events is only allowed at Team Leader's meeting.

A penalty of RM50 will be imposed for each event scratched on competition day, and the swimmer may request to swim in the other subsequent event/s entered for that day. No penalty will be imposed upon presentation of medical certificate. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day on

presentation of a medical certificate.

17. Jury of Appeal : Jury of Appeal shall comprise of three (3) members from the Organising

Committee and two (2) Team Managers from participating clubs not involved

in the Appeal.

19. Covid-19 SOP

- The standard operating procedures (SOP) for control and prevention of Covid-19 disease applies.
 - a) All swimmers, officials and supporters are encouraged to be vaccinated prior to the meet. Unvaccinated swimmers are to be accompanied by fully vaccinated parents.
 - b) Only one (1) vaccinated accompanying parent is allowed to accompany young swimmers in the Group 3, 4 & 5. Spectators must be seated at the gallery and they are not allowed onto the pool deck nor Marshal Room.
 - c) Only one (1) authorized Team Manager is allowed to the Secretariat/Control Room to check on results/DQ, collect certificates, etc.
 - d) The meet is subject to the approval of the venue owner and relevant authorities.
 - e) The organizer and/or venue owner may refuse entry of spectators to the stadium if the seating capacity is crowded.
 - f) In the event of compound by the authority on any participant or spectator for not adhering to SOPs, the compound shall be borne fully by the offenders.
 - g) The organizer, Persatuan Renang Amatur Kuala Lumpur (PRAKL) reserves the right to amend the rules, cancel/postpone the meet based on prevailing condition of the pandemic Covid-19 at the crucial time nearing the meet.
