### **Competition Rules**

1. Name of Meet : MAS/NSC/MILO Junior Splash Swim 2023 - LEG 1

2. Aim : The aim of the Junior Splash Swim as the name suggests, is to

provide an additional and suitable platform to encourage junior swimmers to be involved in competitions and to identify potential

swimmers at junior levels age 14 years and under.

3. Venue : National Aquatic Centre, Kuala Lumpur Sports City, Bukit Jalil,

Kuala Lumpur

**5. Eligibility** : 5.1 Members from affiliates of Malaysia Swimming Federation and Kuala Lumpur Amateur Swimming Association.

5.2 Para swimmers as sanctioned by Malaysia Swimming

Federation.

5.3 No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.

**6. Entry Restriction** : 6.1 Each club is limited to 120 swimmers per team

6.2 Team Event is limited to one (1) relay team per affiliate

**7. Date of Reckoning** : 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2023

8. Age Groups

Group	Age	Born Between
Group 2	13 to 14 years	2/1/2008 to 1/1/2010
Group 3	11 to 12 years	2/1/2010 to 1/1/2012
Group 4	9 to 10 years	2/1/2012 to 1/1/2014
Group 5	6 to 8 years	2/1/2014 to 1/1/2017

Swimmers are only eligible to swim in their respective age groupings. No swimmers are allowed to swim up in the Relay Events.

9. Competition Format

All events will be held on Time Final basis.

10. Awards

- 10.1 Swimmers who obtained top 3 positions for each event shall be awarded medals and Certificate of Achievements.

  All participants will be awarded Certificate of Participations.
- 10.2 Events with less than 3 swimmers may swim combined with another age group but ranked separately.
- 10.3 Swimmers will be awarded points under each affiliate to determine the Champion Club as follows:

#### 11. Entry Fees

The following fees are payable:

- 11.1 Individual entry fee of RM120.00 per swimmer regardless of the number of entries; and
- 11.2 Team entry fee of RM40.00 per relay event.
- 11.3 Total entry fee is payable to PRAKL as per final entry checklist. Upon checklist confirmation by participating affiliates, there will be no revision to the entry fees in the event of subsequent withdrawals/scratching. No invoice will be issued.

14. Team Leaders' Meeting

: Two (2) Team Leaders/Coaches are allowed to attend the Team Managers meeting scheduled as follows:-

## 15. Events Scratching/ Penalty

- 15.1 Scratching or withdrawal of events is only allowed at Team Managers' meeting.
- 15.2 A penalty of RM50/event shall be imposed for each event withdrawn (WDR) on the day of the meet or No Show (NS) or Did Not Swim (DNS). The penalty must be paid before the swimmer's next event on the same day.
- 15.3 If withdrawal of event is due to medical reason, a medical certificate must be furnished to the Secretariat by the Team Manager. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day upon presentation of a medical certificate.

# 16. Pool Testing/ Warm-Up

- 16.1 The pool will be opened for pool testing on the eve of competition between 10:00 am. to 6:00 pm. and on competition days at 6:15 am. each day.
  - 16.2 There will not be any specific lanes allocation for clubs/teams for the warm-up sessions, however the outer lanes 0 and 9 on both ends of the pool shall be reserved for plunging and backstroke start practices only.
  - 16.3 No fins, paddles nor snorkels can be used during the warm-up.
  - 16.4 Swimmers must clear the competition pool for the race by 7:45 am.

- 17. Results
- 17.1 Unofficial results can be viewed from Meet Mobile App.
  - 17.2 Official results will be posted online. No hardcopy of results will be distributed.

18. Protest

: Protests are allowed against the decision of Referee. Protest must be submitted in writing by the Team Manager to the Referee within 30 minutes of the display of official results, accompanied with a deposit of RM200.

#### 19. Jury of Appeal

Jury of Appeal shall comprise of three (3) members from the Organising Committee and two (2) Team Managers from participating clubs not involved in the Appeal.
