COMPETITION RULES

1. **Venue** : National Aquatic Centre, Kuala Lumpur Sports City, Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala Lumpur.
2. **Date/Time** :

3. **Competition Rules & Format** :
 - 3.1 The World Aquatic rules on swimming shall apply for this championships, subject to final decisions by the referees and organizing committee.
 - 3.2 All events shall be held on Time Final basis.
4. **Qualifying Meet** : This meet shall be a qualifying meet to :
 - a) 60th Malaysia Invitational Age Group Swimming Championships 2025. The qualifying times are as stated in the attached appendix.
 - b) 67th Malaysia Open Swimming Championships 2025.
5. **Entry Restriction** :
 - 5.1 Individual Events – NT (No Time) entry is not allowed . Please submit an estimated training times for new swimmers without previous swim record.
 - 5.2 Team Events - One (1) team per affiliate (club/school)
The relay entry forms with swimmers' names in the right order of strokes to be swum must be submitted to the Secretariat/Control Room before lunch break on the day of competition, failing which the team's entry shall be denied.
6. **Eligibility** :
 - 6.1 Only members from approved affiliates and associates of Kuala Lumpur Aquatics.
 - 6.2 No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.
7. **Age Groups** :
 - 7.1 The date of reckoning is **31st December, 2025.**

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- 7.2 Swimmers are only eligible to swim in their respective age groups.
- 7.3 Open swimmers will swim combined but scored separately.
- 7.4 No swimmers are allowed to swim-up to another age group for Relay Events.

8. Hy-Tek Entries

- 8.1 All entries are to be submitted electronically via the Hy-tek Team Manager software and to be emailed to [REDACTED]. The event file for import into Hy- Tek Team Manager is as attached.
- 8.2 Those who do not own the software are advised to download a free version of Team Manager Lite from [REDACTED].

9. Entry Fees

- 9.1 A flat entry fee of **RM125.00 per swimmer** is imposed regardless of number of entries. The Relay Entry Fee is **RM40 per team** event.
- 9.2 Any late entry submission is subject to the acceptance by Organising Committee, with the imposition of late entry fee of **RM250 per swimmer** & relay entry fee of **RM80 per team** for any entries received after the closing deadline.
- 9.3 Total entry fee is payable to Kuala Lumpur Aquatics as per final entry checklist and latest by the payment deadline imposed.
- 9.4 Upon checklist confirmation by participating affiliates, there will be no revision nor refund of the entry fees due to withdrawals at team manager's meeting.
- 9.5 The organizer reserves the right to disallow swimmers from participating in the meet should the affiliation fees of the club/school or the entry fees of the swimmers remain unpaid on the first day of the competition.
- 9.6 All entry fees must be paid prior to the competition date preferably by bank transfer to:-

- 9.7 Kindly email a copy of the online payment confirmation / bank-in slip to [REDACTED] as proof of payment for issuance of official receipt.



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10. **Events Scratching/ Penalty** :
- 10.1 Scratching of events is only allowed at Team Managers' meeting.
 - 10.2 A penalty of **RM100/event** shall be imposed for each event withdrawn (WDR) on the day of the meet or No Show (NS) or Did Not Swim (DNS). The penalty must be paid before the swimmer's next event on the same day.
 - 10.3 If withdrawal of event is due to medical reason, a medical certificate must be provided to the Secretariat by the Team Manager. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day upon presentation of a medical certificate.

11. **Pool Testing/ Warm-Up** :
- 11.1 The pool will be opened for pool testing on the eve of competition (15th January 2025) between 9:30 am. to 3:00 pm. and on competition days at 6:30 am. each day.
 - 11.2 There will not be any specific lanes allocation for clubs/teams for the warm-up sessions, however the outer lanes 0 and 9 on both ends of the pool shall be reserved for plunging and backstroke start practices only.
 - 11.3 No fins, bands nor snorkels can be used during the warm-up.
 - 11.4 All swimmers and coaches must clear the competition pool for the race by 7:45 am.

12. **Combined Events** :
- 12.1 The 1500m free & 800m free events will be combined for Group Open, 1, 2 & 3 to be swum together but scored separately.
 - 12.2 Other events with less than 3 swimmers may be swum combined with another age group but will be scored separately.

13. **Results** :
- Unofficial results can be viewed from Meet Mobile App. (charges apply). Official results will be available online via a shared folder. Please scan the QR code below. Hardcopy of results will NOT be distributed.

14. **Awards** :
- 14.1 Medals and achievement certificates for top 3 positions will be awarded and can be claimed from the Prize Steward at the office.
 - 14.2 For event with 3 swimmers or less, medals will only be awarded based on minus-one rule. In the event of 1 swimmer, medal will be awarded if the meet record is broken.
 - 14.3 There will be no official victory ceremony.
 - 14.4 Each participant will receive a Certificate of Participation.



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15. **Closing Date** : 15.1 All completed entries are to be submitted to the secretariat before or latest [REDACTED] Late entries will be subjected to rule 9.2.
- 15.2 A confirmation of entries received and a checklist will be issued within 7 days from the closing date.
16. **Key Time Line** : 16.1 All teams are to observe the important deadlines below :

- 16.2 Team Managers' meeting is scheduled at the Marshal Room, National Aquatic Centre, Bukit Jalil
17. **Protest** : 17.1 Protest is allowed against the decision of Referee, provided the official protest form is submitted in writing by the Team Manager to the Referee within 30 minutes of the display of official results, accompanied with a deposit of RM400.
- 17.2 If the Referee rejects the protest, the reason(s) for the decision will be explained to the complainant. The Team Manager may then further appeal against the decision to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.
- 17.3 If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited by the Organising Committee. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.
18. **Jury of Appeal** : Jury of Appeal shall comprise of three (3) members from the Technical Committee and two (2) Team Managers from participating clubs not involved in the Appeal.
19. **Facilities** : 19.1 Spectators' seating is available on a first come first served basis. Do not pre-book seatings or paste any reservation labels. Mats or other items used to pre-book a place will be removed by the venue manager without notice.
- 19.2 Pool deck access is only for participants, authorized coaches and team managers only.
- 19.3 Kindly ensure the stadium and pool deck is kept clean at all times. Please clear rubbish from the spectators' seats at the end of the meet each day.
- 19.4 The diving platforms and springboards are out of bounds at all times.
- 19.5 Parking is available at the public car parks surrounding the national stadiums. Please do not park at unauthorized space to avoid clamping by the stadium authorities.
