COMPETITION RULES

1. Name of Meet: The swimming meet shall be named the 2nd KL Klasik Invitational Friendly Swim Meet 2025 ('KL Klasik').

2. **Aim** : The aim of the invitational friendly meet is to foster good relationships among

swim clubs in Malaysia, especially around Klang Valley. KL Klasik provides an additional and suitable platform to encourage new learners to be involved in swimming competitions, getting themselves accustomed to World Aquatics

swimming rules and to identify potential achievers from the grassroot.

3. Venue : National Aquatic Centre, Kuala Lumpur Sports City, Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala

5. Competition Rules & Format

- 5.1 The World Aquatic rules on swimming shall apply for this swim meet, subject to final decisions by the referees and organizing committee.
- 5.2 The organising committee reserves the right to amend any rules deemed fit to suit the condition of the local meet.
- 5.3 All events will be held on Time Final basis.
- 6. Entry Restriction
- 6.1 Individual Events NT (No Time) entry is not allowed . Please submit an estimated training times for new swimmers without previous swim record.
- 6.2 Team Events One (1) team per affiliate (club/school)

 The relay entry forms with swimmers' names in the right order must be submitted to the Secretariat before lunch break on the day of competition or one hour before the start of the session, failing which the team's entry shall be denied.
- 7. Eligibility
- a) Affiliates members of Malaysia Aquatics and Kuala Lumpur Aquatics
- b) Sports clubs & academies properly constituted under Sports Commission of Malaysia or Companies Commission of Malaysia.
- c) School swimming clubs properly constituted under the schools.
- d) Swimmers who have represented their states in the current and preceding 2 years, either in National Age Group or MSSM, shall be classified as State Swimmers. Each team must identify them separately in a list.
- e) Swimmers who are not in the state teams shall be classified as Novice.
- f) No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.

8. **Age Groups** : 8.1 The date of reckoning is based on age as at 31st December, 2025.

Group 1	16 to 18 years	Born in 2007 to 2009
Group 2	14 to 15 years	Born in 2010 to 2011
Group 3	12 to 13 years	Born in 2012 to 2013
Group 4	10 to11 years	Born in 2014 to 2015
Group 5	6 to 9 years	Born in 2016 to 2019

- 8.2 Swimmers are only eligible to swim in their respective age groups.
- 8.3 No swimmers are allowed to swim-up to another age group for Relay Events.
- 9. **Hy-Tek Entries**

10.	Entry Fees	:	10.1	A flat entry fee of RM125.00 per swimmer is imposed regardle	
				number of entries. The Relay Entry Fee is RM60 per team event.	

- 10.2 Total entry fee is payable to Persatuan Renang Amatur Kuala Lumpur as per final entry checklist and latest by the payment deadline imposed.
- 10.3 Upon checklist confirmation by participating affiliates, there will be no revision nor refund of the entry fees due to withdrawals at team manager's meeting.
- 10.4 All entry fees must be paid prior to the competition date or at the Team Managers' Meeting preferably by interbank transfer to:-

11.	Events : Scratching/ Penalty	11.1 11.2 11.3	Scratching of events is only allowed at Team Managers' meeting. A penalty of RM50/event shall be imposed for each event withdrawn (WDR) on the day of the meet or No Show (NS) or Did Not Swim (DNS). The penalty must be paid before the swimmer's next event on the same day. The swimmer will be allowed to swim only after settlement of the penalty imposed. If withdrawal of event is due to medical reason, a medical certificate must be furnished to the Secretariat by the Team Manager. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day upon presentation of a medical certificate.
12.	Pool : Testing/ Warm-Up	12.1 12.2 12.3 12.4	The pool will be opened for pool testing on the eve of competition between 9:30 am. to 3:00 pm. and on competition days at 6:30 am. each day. There will not be any specific lanes allocation for clubs/teams for the warm-up sessions, however the outer lanes 0 and 9 on both ends of the pool shall be reserved for plunging and backstroke start practices only. No fins, bands nor snorkels can be used during the warm-up. Swimmers must clear the competition pool for the race by 7:45 am.
13.	Combined : Events	13.1	Events with less than 3 swimmers may be swum combined with another age group but will be scored separately. In the case of only one participating swimmer in an event, medal and points will not be awarded
14.	Awards :	14.1 14.2 14.3 14.4 14.4	Medals and achievement certificates for top 3 positions will be awarded to both novice and state swimmers. For event with 3 swimmers or less, medals will only be awarded based on minus-one rule. In the event of 1 swimmer, no medal will be awarded. Under novice category, achievement ribbons and certificates will be awarded to positions 4 th , 5 th & 6 th . There will be no victory ceremony. Each participant will receive a Certificate of Participation.
15.	Closing : Date	15.1 15.2	A confirmation of entries received and a checklist will be issued within

Key Time Line: 16.1 All teams are to observe the important deadlines below:

- 16.2 Team Managers' meeting is scheduled at the Marshaling Room, National Aquatic Centre, Bukit Jalil
- 17. Results : Unofficial results can be viewed from Meet Mobile App. (charges apply). Official results will be available online via a shared folder, to be notified in due course. No hardcopy of results will be distributed.
- Appeal 18.1 Appeal is allowed against the decision of Referee, provided it is submitted using the prescribed form in writing by the Team Manager to the Referee, within 30 minutes of the display of official results, accompanied with a deposit of RM400.
 - 18.2 The Referee will present the appeal to the Chair of the Jury of Appeal, who will review the appeal and determine its validity.
 - 18.3 If the Chair deems the appeal to be invalid on the swimmer's rule infraction, the deposit shall be forfeited. If the appeal is deemed to be valid, the Chair shall initiate a review by the Jury of Appeal which shall render a final decision on the appeal as soon as reasonably practical. The Chair's decision regarding validity is final.
 - 18.4 The Jury of Appeal shall be comprised of three members. One of the three members shall be the designated Chair. The three members shall be assigned by the Organising Chairman.
- 19. **Facilities** 19.1 Spectators' seating is available on a first come first served basis. Do not prebook seatings or paste any reservation labels.
 - 19.2 Pool deck access is only for participants, authorized coaches and team managers only.
 - 19.3 Kindly ensure the stadium and pool deck is kept clean at all times. Please clear rubbish from the spectators' seats at the end of the meet each day.
 - 19.4 The diving platforms and springboards are out of bounds at all times.
 - 19.5 Parking is available at the public car parks surrounding the national stadiums. Please do not park at unauthorized space to avoid clamping by the stadium authorities.
