## 2nd JOHOR CLOSED SWIMMING MEET 2026

### COMPETITION RULES

1. **Name of Meet** : The swimming meet shall be named the **2nd JOHOR CLOSED SWIMMING MEET 2026**.
2. **Aim** : The **2nd JOHOR CLOSED SWIMMING MEET 2026** is a local competition that gives young and new swimmers in Johor the chance to **showcase their potential** and gain experience in a competitive setting.
3. **Venue** : Educity Sports Complex

5. **Competition Rules & Format** :
- 5.1 The World Aquatic rules on swimming shall apply for this swim meet, subject to final decisions by the referees and organizing committee.
- 5.2 The organising committee reserves the right to amend any rules deemed fit to suit the condition of the local meet.
- 5.3 All events will be held on Time Final basis.
6. **Entry Restriction** :
- 6.1 Individual Events – NT (No Time) entry is not allowed . Please submit an estimated training times for new swimmers without previous swim record.
- 6.2 Team Events- One (1) team per affiliate (club/school) The relay entry forms with swimmers' names in the right order must be submitted to the Secretariat before lunch break on the day of competition or one hour before the start of the session, failing which the team's entry shall be denied.

7. **Eligibility** :

- 7.1 Affiliates members of Malaysia Aquatics and Persatuan Renang Amatur Johor
- 7.2 Sports clubs & academies properly constituted under Sports Commission of Malaysia or Companies Commission of Malaysia.
- 7.3 School swimming clubs properly constituted under the schools.

7.4 Medalists who have represented their states in the current and preceding 2 years (2025 & 2026), either in JAG, National Age Group, Malaysia Open, MSSJ, Swim Splash, Sports Excel or MSSM, shall be classified as Time Trial Swimmers. Each team must identify them separately in a list. (No medals will be awarded)

7.5 Swimmers who are not in the state teams shall be classified as Novice.

7.6 No independent unattached swimmers are allowed.

## 8. Age Group

: 8.1 The date of reckoning is based on age as at 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2026.

Group	Age	Year of Birth
Group 1	16 - 18	Born in 2008 to 2010
Group 2	14 - 15	Born in 2011 to 2012
Group 3	12 - 13	Born in 2013 to 2014
Group 4	10 - 11	Born in 2015 to 2016
Group 5	8 - 9	Born on 2017 to 2018
Group 6	6 - 7	Born on 2019 – 2020.

8.2 Swimmers are only eligible to swim in the irrespective age groups.

8.3 No swimmers are allowed to swim-up to another age group for Relay Events.

## 9. Hy-Tek Entries

: 9.1 All entries are to be submitted electronically via the Hy-Tek Team Manager software and to be emailed to persatuanrenangamaturjohor@gmail.com. The event file for import into Hy-Tek Team Manager is as attached.

## 10 Entry Fees

: 10.1 **A flat entry fee of RM120 per swimmer is imposed regardless of number of entries. The Relay Entry Fee is RM60 per team event.**

**11 Events Scratching /  
Penalty**

: 11.1

11.2 A penalty of RM100/event shall be imposed for each event withdrawn (WDR) on the day of the meet or No Show (NS) or Did Not Swim (DNS).

The penalty must be paid before before the swimmer's next event on the same day. The swimmer will be allowed to swim only after settlement of the penalty imposed.

11.3 If withdrawal of event is due to medical reason, a medical certificate must be furnished to the Secretariat by the Team Manager. A swimmer is deemed to be unfit to swim for the rest of the day upon presentation of a medical certificate.

**12 Pool Testing /  
Warm-up**

12.1 The pool will be opened for pool testing on the eve of competition between 2:00 pm. to 4:30 pm. and on competition days at 6:45 am.each day.

12.2 There will not be any specific lanes allocation for clubs/teams for the warm-up sessions, however the outer lanes 1 and 8 on both ends of the pool shall be reserved for plunging and backstroke start practices only.

12.3 No fins, bands nor snorkels can be used during the warm-up.

12.4 Swimmers must clear the competition pool for the race by 8:00 am.

**13 Combined Events**

:

13.1 Events with less than 3 swimmers may be swum combined with another age group but will be scored separately.

13.2 In the case of only one participating swimmer in an event, medal and points will not be awarded

**14 Awards**

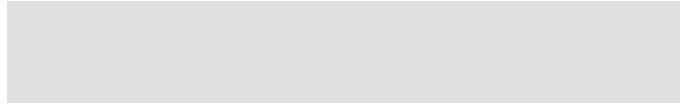

14.1 Medals for top 3 positions will be awarded to novice swimmers only.

14.2 For event with 3 swimmers or less, medals will only be awarded based on minus-one rule. In the event of 1 swimmer, no medal will be awarded.

14.3 Each participant will receive a Certificate of Participation.

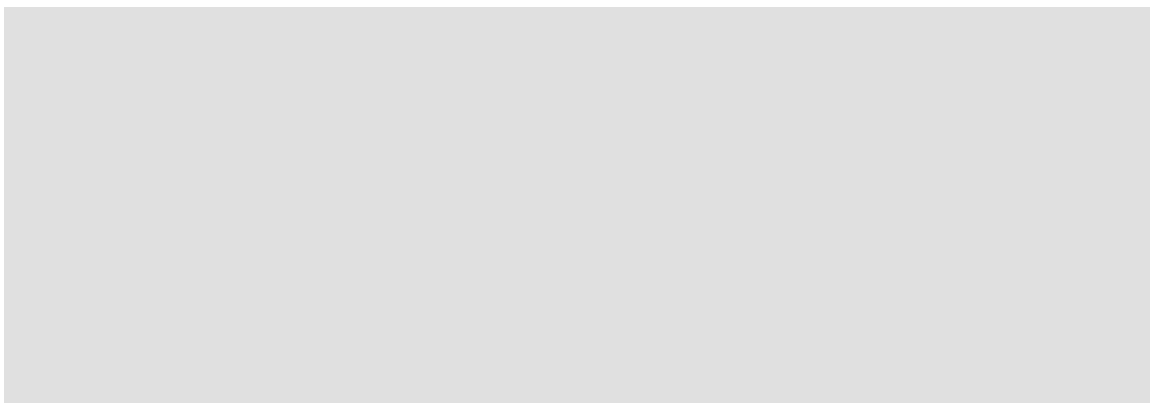
**15 Closing Date** : 15.1



15.2 A confirmation of entries received and a checklist will be issued within 3 days from the closing date.

**17 Results** : 17.1

Official results will be available online via a shared folder, to be notified in due course. No hardcopy of results will be distributed.

**18 Appeal** : 18.1

Appeal is allowed against the decision of Referee, provided it is submitted using the prescribed form in writing by the Team Manager to the Referee, within 30 minutes of the display of official results, accompanied with a deposit of RM400.

18.2 The Referee will present the appeal to the Chair of the Jury of Appeal ,who will review the appeal and determine its validity.

18.3 If the Chair deems the appeal to be invalid on the swimmer's rule infraction, the deposit shall be forfeited. If the appeal is deemed to be valid, the Chair shall initiate a review by the Jury of Appeal which shall render a final decision on the appeal as soon as reasonably practical.  
The Chair's decision regarding validity is final.

18.4 The Jury of Appeal shall be comprised of three members. One of the three members shall be the designated Chair. The three members shall be assigned by the Organising Chairman.

**19 Facilities**

- 19.1 Spectators' seating is available on a first come first served basis. Do not pre-book seatings or paste any reservation labels.
